2 Fees

The entry fee now reflects the increase in FAI fee and is £656.80 ie €775 at exchange rate 1.18; this is a fixed price.

The aerotow fee of €50/£42.40 may change depending on fuel costs and exchange rate at the time of the competition. At the time of writing, fuel costs are 40% higher than when we made the bid and the situation is very uncertain. Teams who pre-pay for aerotows will be asked to pay the additional cost later if the tow cost rises.

2 Making an Official Entry

Official entries are due by 31 March. To make an Official Entry, teams should follow the steps in the Local Procedures. Payment can be made by credit card or bank transfer; if paying by bank transfer, please allow 7 days for funds to reach the pilot accounts.
